

Got Talent? 2012 Rules

Showcasing Huron Valley and Neighboring Communities

1. Performers, K-12 in the Youth Division, and Adults 18 years of age or older in the Adult Division, will compete for two Grand Prizes of \$1,000. All decisions of the “Got Talent?” Judges are final.
2. The events will take place as follows:
 - Call for Talent (open audition)- Saturday, January 21, 2012, White Lake Middle 9am- 2pm
“PLEASE NOTE: The Call is not open to an actual audience. The participant(s) perform in front of a group of judges, while parents and loved ones wait for them in our holding area. The participant(s) will not be seen by anyone besides the judges.”
 - Semi-Final (by invitation) – Saturday, March 3, 2012 9am – 1pm (assigned times)
Center for Performing Arts, Lakeland High
 - Final (by invitation) – Saturday, April 14, 2012 7pm
Center for Performing Arts, Milford High
3. A minimum of one member of each Youth Division act **must have a KLAA connection (Huron Valley and the following school districts: Brighton, Fenton, Grand Blanc, Hartland, Holly, Howell, Livonia, Northville, Novi, Pinckney, Plymouth, South Lyon, Walled Lake, Waterford, Wayne, Westland)**. All Youth Division members must meet K-12 requirement, (excluding piano accompanist)
4. Adult Division members are for those that are no longer in high school, so if your 18 and still in High School, you compete in the Youth Division. If one member of the group is an adult, then everyone is in that group.
5. Only one registration per performer/group is permitted. A solo performer may also register with a group; a separate registration fee will be required.
6. “Got Talent?” retains the right to refuse any entry, or terminate a performance that conflicts with this family-friendly event. For all performances with lyrics, a lyric sheet must be provided for the Semi-Final and the Final. In the event a performance is cancelled while in progress, the performer’s registration fee will not be refunded.
6. Performance length will be limited as follows:
 - Call for Talent – no longer than 2 minutes, points will be deducted for going over
 - Semi-finals – no longer than 3 minutes, points will be deducted for going over
 - Finals – no longer than 4 minutes, points will be deducted for going over
7. Equipment will be provided as follows:
 - Call for Talent – Vocalist – A cappella or CD accompaniment; Instrumentalists – PA System
Dancers – Marley floor (approx. 12x20), standard CD player
 - Semi-finals – PA System and Marley Floor (approx. 12x20)(Bands must bring their own equipment for quick set up)
 - Finals – PA System and Marley Floor (approx. 12x20) (Bands must bring their own equipment for quick set up)
8. Neither “Got Talent?” nor its sponsors will be responsible for loss or damage to personal property belonging to, or in the care of, the performers.
9. “Got Talent?” retains the right to audio / videotape all performances. Such videotape will be the sole property of “Got Talent?” and may be used in promotions related to “Got Talent?”.
10. The 2012 “Got Talent?” winner(s) may be contacted to be involved at the 2013 “Got Talent?”
11. The prize winner(s) are solely responsible for all taxes levied or assessed on the cash prize. The prize winner(s) will be required to show proof of age and residency, and complete forms if necessary.
12. No refunds will be permitted, under any circumstances.
