Eligibility

This show is open to Michigan artists of all ages, living and/or working in Michigan, with special categories for those under 18 years of age.

Art submitted is not to exceed 48" in any direction. Art must have been completed after 2008 and not previously exhibited at a VFAA show. One entry equals one framed piece.

Exhibition

All work accepted into **Views & Visions** will be on exhibit in the HVCA Gallery from **Friday, Nov 5 through Sunday, Nov 28, 2010.**

Pick up of artwork will be **Monday, Nov 29 - 10:00 a.m. 'til Noon and 5:00 p.m. 'til 7:00 p.m.**

Important: Work not picked up by 7:00 p.m. will be left at the artist's own risk.

Agreement

Submission of work to the juror constitutes compliance with all the conditions stated in this prospectus. The jurors' decisions are final. Participating artists will be notified of jury results by mail. Accepted works will remain as placed by the **Views & Visions** committee, and will not be withdrawn until the close of the exhibit.

A catalog of the show will be produced. The VFAA reserves the right to reproduce all entries accepted for the show, regardless of copyright. They will be used only for publicity, catalog and educational purposes related to the **Views & Visions** Show & Sale. By agreeing to be in the show the artist accepts this condition.

\$400 Views & Visions 2010 Award

\$200 Best Vision 2010

\$50 Joseph Brancik Memorial Award (for artists under 18)

Plus several honorable mention awards in different denominations for adults and children.

Entry Fees

VFAA & HVCA Members: \$25.00 for up to three entries

Non-Members: \$35.00 for up to three entries

Under Age 18: \$5.00 per entry (please put artist's age on entry form) Youth may enter and be judged as an adult by paying the adult fee.

Entry fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. Check or money order, made payable to VFAA, accepted.

Fees/Sales

All artwork must be priced, or marked Not for Sale (NFS). Prices will be listed in the **Views & Visions** catalog. NO CHANGES IN PRICE OR SUBSTITUTION OF ART CAN BE MADE AFTER ENTRY. HVCA, a non-profit organization, will take a 25% sales commission for its outreach programs.

Entry Procedure

- ❖ Your email subject line should be your name
- ❖ JPEG file name should match the title of the piece
- ❖ Include in your email the Title, Medium, Price (or NFS) and Size (including frame) of each piece.
- ❖ All images must be in JPEG (.jpg) format. No slides or CD images accepted.
 - 1 image for 2 dimensional art
 - 3 images (one detail) for 3 dimensional art
 - Image positioned in upright viewing manner
 - Resolution no less than 72 dpi and no more than 300 dpi
 - Viewing: no more than 800 pixels in height or width
 - Computer memory: no more than 1MB
- ❖ Complete the entry form. Print or type all information exactly as you wish it to appear in all **Views and Visions** materials. Keep a copy for your records.

❖ Accepted Art Presentation

Two-dimensional work must be framed and ready for hanging with wire securely affixed to back. NO saw-tooth hangers are accepted. Three-dimensional art must be ready for presentation with instructions and mounting hardware, if needed, for display. If, in the opinion of the juror or committee, accepted work is not suitably prepared for exhibit, or deemed to have been misrepresented in its submission, the work will be disqualified. All two-dimensional work must be labeled on the reverse side, upper right hand corner, using the labels provided.

Checklist:

- Complete and mail entry form, jury notification form, and liability statement.
- Include cash, check or money order made payable to **VFAA**.
- Include self-addressed stamped envelope.
- Affix labels to reverse side of art, upper right-hand corner.
- Bring accepted entries to the **HVCA**, 205 West Livingston Road, Highland, MI. 48357 on Tuesday, Nov 2: 5:00 p.m. 'til 7:00 p.m. or Wednesday, Nov 3: 10:00 a.m. 'til Noon.
- Exhibited work must be reclaimed by artist at the **HVCA**, 205 West Livingston Road, Highland, MI. 48357 on Monday, Nov 29 - 10:00 a.m. 'til Noon and 5:00 p.m. 'til 7:00 p.m.
Work not picked up by 7:00 p.m. will be left at the artist's own risk.
