CALL FOR ARTISTS

The Huron Valley Council for the Arts is proud to announce their upcoming concert and art show, **OUR HEROES**. This concert and art show is being held to honor active duty military, veterans, reserve forces, and first responders.

We are looking for artwork from active duty military, veterans, reserve forces, and first responders to include in our art show. Please share this information with all eligible persons. Description:

Open to all active duty military, veterans, reserve forces, and first responders.

Huron Valley Council for the Arts is now accepting art entries in conjunction with the *OUR HEROES* concert to be held at Lakeland High School in White Lake Township, MI.

- » Entrants must be active duty military, veterans, reserve forces, and first responders.
- » All forms of visual arts are acceptable. Military themed work is not required. All artwork must be "family appropriate", no sexual, bloody or violent content allowed. Up to 3 pieces per artist may be allowed with possible option to include more if space allows. Artists are not required to sell their art.
- » One-of-a-kind, original artwork only is acceptable.
- » Deadline for Entries: Saturday, Oct 19, 2019. Email Notification of Acceptance by: Saturday, Oct 26, 2019
- » All artwork must be ready to hang with appropriate wire to hold pieces. No Sawtooth Hangers. Pieces to be displayed on pedestals should have an appropriate stand or easel if applicable.
- » Artwork will be displayed by HVCA program art committee members. Committee members will have final jurisdiction on placement of work in gallery area of Lakeland High School.

- » Accepted entrance into this show entitles artist to 1 free concert ticket.
 - » Artwork must be received by Nov 10, 2019. Delivery of work to be coordinated with HVCA program art committee upon acceptance to show. All artwork must have a tag with artist's name and phone number attached.
 - » Unsold artwork may be taken home after the event for those artists attending the event. Artists not attending event must pick up their artwork by Nov 17, 2019.
 - » Due to limited storage space, artwork left beyond Nov 20, 2019 will not be guaranteed safe storage.
 - » All sales of art during the evening of the event will be processed through HVCA with a 25% commission fee paid to HVCA.
 - » An 'Artist Release Form' must be signed by the artist and submitted with your entry.
 - » The HVCA program art committee has final approval for all art submitted for exhibit.
 - » Subject matter may not contain copyrighted materials or characters.

Terms of Entry for Entrants:

- » The application fee has been waived for this event.
- » If you do not have Internet access, you may submit a hard copy by completing the application form. You will need to send photos of the work (with description, size, media, title and price if for sale) that you wish to have considered. Please mail to: *OUR HEROES*, 5300 Lake Grove Dr, White Lake, MI 48383. Retain a copy of this document for reference.

Insurance:

- » HVCA will exercise all reasonable care with your original artwork. However, Lakeland High School and Huron Valley Schools, HVCA, its directors, members, volunteers and/or anyone connected with the concert will not be responsible for the loss or damage to artwork. It is suggested the artist carry insurance.

Presentation:

- » All artwork must be delivered ready for presentation. Framed artwork must be delivered with appropriate glass or Plexiglas and properly secured hanging wire. No saw-tooth hangers please.

- » Artwork delivered unprepared for presentation WILL NOT be accepted. Artwork will be installed by the HVCA Program Art Committee. The committee has final jurisdiction over where pieces will hang and has final approval for all art submitted for exhibit.

Sales & Copyrights:

- » A commission of 25% will be charged on all artwork sold. Artists are not required to sell their art.
- » If accepted, your entry grants HVCA permission to photograph your work and/or use your images for promotional or educational purposes only. *OUR HEROES* Concert will be promoted by HVCA's marketing team via HVCA website, social media, and press releases. All personal advertising by the artist will be at their own expense.
- » Your submission of artwork constitutes an agreement to comply with all conditions set forth in these guidelines. The Program Art Committee reserves the right to reject any artwork not accurately represented by photos or electronic image. The decision of the committee is final.

Delivery:

- » Hand delivery preferred, but work may be shipped. Pack securely in a container capable of using for return, and include prepaid return shipping.
- » Location for delivery or mailing will be provided upon acceptance
- » Artists must deliver accepted work between 11 am and 3 pm on Sunday, Nov 10, 2019, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Program Art Committee at OurHeroesArt@yahoo.com.
- » All artwork must be picked up between 11 am and 3 pm on Sunday, Nov 17, 2019. Any work not picked up will be disposed of at the discretion of the program art committee. We have no ability to store any item not picked up. Shipped work must arrive 2 weeks prior to the concert and will be returned within two weeks after the concert.

Release and Waiver of Liability for Art Exhibit:

- » An 'Artist Release Form' must be signed by the artist and submitted with your entry.
- » By signing the 'Artist Release Form' the artist acknowledges and agrees that participation in *OUR HEROES* art show conducted by HVCA involves the possibility that property, including, without limitation, any art or other items (collectively, the 'Property') may be damaged, lost or stolen. The artist acknowledges that he/she is assuming the risk of loss of the Property by participating in the exhibition.
